COUNCILLOR NOMINATION

Organisational members are required to nominate a Councillor who will act as the main point of contact with us and will have authority to vote on behalf of the nominating organisation at our Annual General Meetings.

Role of the Councillor

Each organisational member must, by notice of writing to ARACY, nominate a candidate for appointment as a Councillor.

Councillors act as the contact for the membership to disseminate ARACY information to members of the organisation.

Councillors will have authority to vote on behalf of organisational members in accordance with the ARACY constitution.

The ARACY Board may, in its absolute discretion, appoint or decline to appoint any nominated candidate as a Councillor, and is not required to give reasons for its decision.

If the Board declines to appoint as a Councillor the candidate who was nominated by a particular organisational member, or if the appointment of a Councillor who was nominated by that organisational member terminates, that organisational member is required to nominate another candidate for appointment as a Councillor. Applications are accepted at the discretion of the Board.
