## About ARACY

Young and Wise is an **online group for young people**. It is run by ARACY..

It helps young people **share their experiences**.

These experiences **help adults make better decisions** about young people.

Young people are **paid** for their time.

Young and Wise is about working with young people — **not** just talking about them.

## About the Roundtables



The Roundtables are held online on a Teams call.

They focus on young people's **wellbeing**.

Wellbeing means what young people need to:

- feel good
- feel safe
- feel strong
- feel healthy
- feel supported

### What happens in each roundtable:

- Young people talk about what helps them feel good every day
- Young people talk about what makes life hard
- Young people share ideas for change



Adults listen and learn from what young people say.

# Applying



You can apply if you:



- Are **8 to 24** years old



- Live in **Australia**



- Want to **share your experiences**

You do **not** need:



- A job or work experience

## The categories



This series is for young people who are one or more of these:

- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- From a Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) background
- From rural, regional or remote areas
- LGBTQIA+
- Autistic or neurodivergent

You can pick more than one.

We know everyone's identity is different and important.



# Accessibility and safety



**We want everyone to feel safe and comfortable.**

You can:

- Tell us about any support or access needs
- Ask questions at any time
- Take part in ways that work for you
- Have someone with you to support you



You choose what you want to share.

# Payment



You will be paid for your time.

If you take part, you will get **\$50 for the roundtable**.



After the session, you can **share your thoughts** in a video or audio message.

You will get **another \$20 for this**.
